

# MUSIC MINOR

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## General Policies

- Admission into the Minor in Music at Lamar University requires an audition. - Students pursuing a Minor in Music must complete MUSI 1306 Music Appreciation as the core curriculum requirement in creative arts.
- A maximum of 6 hours of MULB courses may be used as credit towards the Minor in Music degree, in total, across both lower and upper divisions. Note: auditions are required for enrollment in most ensemble courses at both lower and upper level.

## Curriculum (18 Hours)

### *Music Theory (3 Hours)*

MUTY 1370 Elements of Music or MUTY 1211 Music Theory I and MUTY 1116 Elementary Sight Singing & Ear Training I

### *Applied Music (4 Hours)*

- The same course number will be repeated and used for both semesters.
- Music Department policies stipulate that all students enrolled in applied lessons must simultaneously enroll in a major ensemble. Students may enroll in an ensemble for credit to satisfy lower or upper division electives in the Music Minor degree program; or they may elect to enroll in a 0-hour version of the ensemble if they no longer need it for their degree plan and do not desire the hour credit.
- Any MUAP 12xx except MUAP 1283

### *Electives (2 Hours)*

Selected from any lower division courses offered by the Department of Music for which pre-requisites have been met.

### *Upper-Division Courses (9 Hours)*

Selected from any upper division courses offered by the Department of Music for which pre-requisites have been met. A maximum of 6 hours of MULB courses may be used as credit towards the Minor in Music degree, in total, across both lower and upper divisions.
